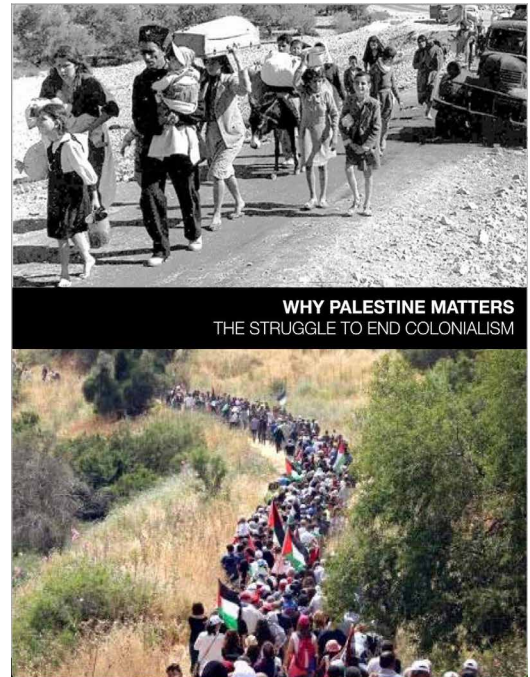

When we think about why Palestine matters, we must consider why human rights matter and why international law is a foundation for global justice. This 4-session course gives substance to Martin Luther King Jr.'s words, “Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere” by giving concrete examples of how all justice struggles are interconnected. The project for human liberation proceeds from understanding and mobilizing these networks of connection.

Did you know???

- US Marines train with Israeli police and military units.
- The Israeli Defense Force (IDF) trains US Immigration Control Enforcement (ICE) agents.
- Across US cities American law enforcement officials train with Israeli police and military units.
- Israeli companies are bidding on contracts to build the Mexican border wall.
- Tear gas canisters made in Jamestown, PA are used in Gaza as well as in Ferguson, MO and other US cities.
- Protesters in Gaza sent tweets to protesters in Ferguson with advice on how to protect themselves from tear gas during the riots in 2014.

In this course you will learn what is meant by intersectionality as it relates to racism, indigenous rights, immigration, refugees, colonialism, cultural appropriation, erasure, and resistance.
